

# I-70 VAIL UNDERPASS - TRAFFIC IMPACTS

# PHASE 1 | APRIL - JUNE 2016 Bridge Construction

The plan is to work Monday through Saturday primarily during the daytime hours, with the option to work seven days a week. The decision to work on Sundays or to move into a 24/7 schedule will be made on a week-to-week basis.

construction occurs on underpass

#### PHASE 1 | APRIL - JUNE 2016

- I-70 East and westbound traffic will be single lane
- · Frontage Roads No impact on Frontage Roads during these months
- Bikes & Foot Traffic No impact on bike paths during these months

#### PHASE 2 | JULY - NOVEMBER 2016

- I-70 Normal traffic flow (narrowed shoulders with a reduced speed limit)
- Frontage Roads Traffic will be one-way single lane detour:
  - > North Frontage Road traffic will travel westbound from Lion's Ridge Loop to Timber Ridge
  - > South Frontage Road will travel eastbound from Cascade Resort to Cascade Crossing (just before Forest Road)
  - > Vail Transit will suspend GREEN route and double frequency on RED route
  - > There will be no impacts to Bustang or ECO Transit operations
- Bikes & Foot Traffic Directed to use the appropriate paths:
  - > North Recreation Trail will be open along a detour just north of project (North Frontage Road)
  - Sore Valley Trail will remain open and is not impacted (South Frontage Road)

# PHASE 3 | NOVEMBER 2016 - MARCH 2017

- I-70 Normal traffic flow
- · Frontage Roads Normal traffic flow
- · Bikes & Foot Traffic Normal traffic flow

### PHASE 4 | APRIL - NOVEMBER 2017

- I-70 Normal traffic flow (narrowed shoulders with a reduced speed limit)
- Frontage Roads Traffic will be one-way single lane detour:
  - > North Frontage Road traffic will travel westbound from Lion's Ridge Loop to Timber Ridge
  - > South Frontage Road will travel eastbound from Cascade Resort to Cascade Crossing (just before Forest Road)
